CONGRATULATIONS! The Housing Authority of Baltimore City (HABC) is pleased to announce that it will accept all 29,812 applications received during the opening period of its Public Housing, Senior Housing, and Mixed-Population waiting lists. This decision was based to effectively broaden housing opportunities and to further fair housing to low-income families in Baltimore City.

HABC will use a random sequence generator to determine the order on the waiting list for all the 29,812 applications received during the **August 1st through August 14th** opening period.

When vacant units become available, HABC will select the applicants in their order on the waiting list and in accordance with HABC's admissions requirements set forth in HABC's [Admissions and Continuing Occupancy Policies](#).

As housing units become available, those next on the waiting lists will be contacted to complete a full eligibility application screening. **To be considered for assistance, applicants must obtain and provide the following information:**

- Valid Photo Identification card (for all family members 18 and older)
- Birth Certificate (for all family members)
- Social Security card (for all family members)
- Income for all family members (must be dated within 60 days of the eligibility appointment)

**Reminder: It's important to keep your contact information (address, phone number, emails) up-to-date at all times.**
