PUBLIC HOUSING CENTRALLY-ADMINISTERED LOCATION-BASED WAITING LIST LOCATION SELECTION FORM

I. Background Information.

The Housing Authority of Baltimore ("HABC") allows applicants to choose the waiting list they want to be placed on. Applicants may choose: (1) the **Centrally-Administered First Available Unit Waiting List (the "First Available Waiting List")**; or (2) the **Centrally-Administered Location-Based Waiting Lists (the "CALBWL")**.

Please note that in HABC's Admissions & Continued Occupancy Policy (the "ACOP"), the **First Available Waiting List** is also referred to as the **CAFAWL**.

The **First Available** option is for applicants who want to be housed more quickly and therefore will accept the first unit offered. What First Available means is that when your name comes to the top of the waiting list for any location for which you qualify, you will be called to view the available apartment and must accept the apartment offer unless you have good cause to refuse the apartment offer. If you refuse the offer without good cause, you will be removed from the waiting list.

CALBWL's allow you to <u>select up to three locations</u> where you would like to live. The CALBWL option is for applicants who only want to consider specific locations for housing. If you are on one, two or three CALBWLs, when your name comes to the top of the waiting list for one of the locations you chose, you will be called to view the available apartment and you must accept the apartment offer unless you have good cause to refuse the offer. If you refuse the offer without good cause, you will be removed from the waiting list.

II. Guidelines to Assist in the Selection Process.

Outlined below are guidelines to assist in the waiting list selection process:

- Only select a location that has the number of bedrooms for which your household is eligible. For example, a family eligible for a four (4) bedroom apartment should NOT choose Douglass Homes because there are no four (4) bedroom apartments at this location. If you are unsure of what bedroom size to select, consult the Waiting List FAQ's for more information on determining apartment size. Please note that if the box is shaded, it means that there are no apartments at the location for that bedroom size.
- Applicants with questions about specific locations can visit www.habc.org/public-housing to
 obtain information on each location, including information on local and community services, i.e.
 transportation, schools etc.

- For additional information on waiting list policies and the differences between the First Available
 Waiting List and CALBWL (the option to be listed on the waiting lists for up to three HABC
 developments), refer to the Waiting List Update FAQ's (Frequently Asked Questions)
 located on the website at https://www.habc.org/habc-information/my-application/ or referring to the Admissions and
 Continued Occupancy Policy (ACOP) located on the website

- Generally, the rent calculation method for all developments is the same; however, some
 developments may have different minimum and maximum rents. HABC has a minimum rent of
 zero. However, there are privately owned sites that have an approved minimum rent that is
 more than zero. Where a minimum rent is established, residents will be required to pay at least
 the amount established as the minimum rent. Sites that have minimum rent:

Albemarle Square: \$50.00Monastery Gardens: \$50.00

1. First Available Option

Applicants who wish to be housed more quickly may want to consider selecting the <u>First Available</u> option. <u>Applicants selecting the First Available option ARE NOT ALLOWED to select any of the locations listed below.</u>

2. Centrally-Administered Location-Based Waiting List

Applicants who wish to be housed only at specific location(s) may select **up to three (3) locations below.** Applicants must place an "X" in the box next to the location where they want to live.
