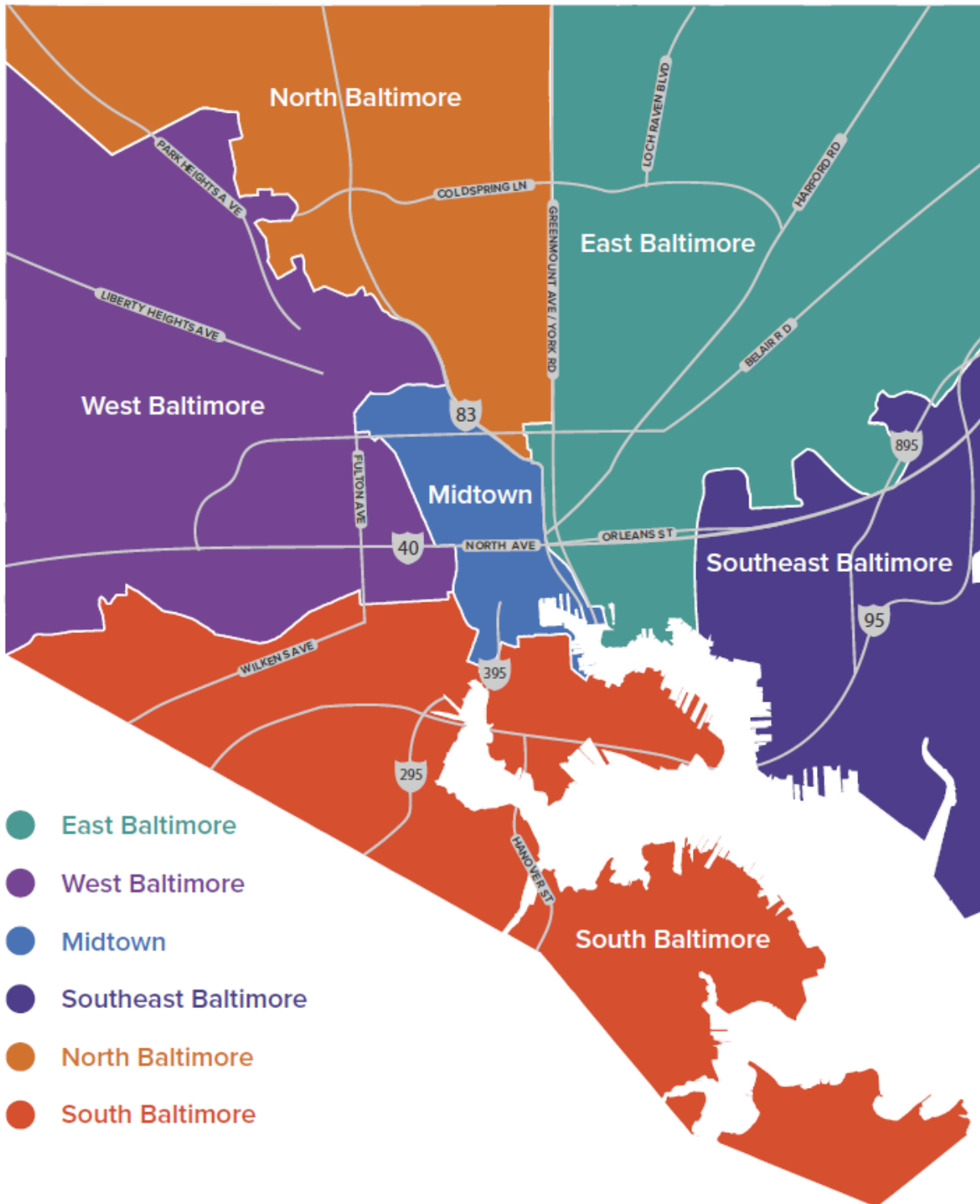

This map shows the different sections of Baltimore City. Below you will find each section of Baltimore City and the HABC developments located in each section.

Property Type Key

(FL) Family Locations: All applicants may live in Family Locations provided the development has the appropriate bedroom size for your household composition based on HABC's occupancy standard policies.

Senior: Senior developments are open to families where the head of household, spouse or co-head is 62 or older.

Scattered Sites: Scattered Sites are units owned by HABC and listed under the Public Housing program. These units are spread out throughout Baltimore City neighborhoods. If you select a scattered site unit, you will not be able to determine the location of the unit.
