

The map below illustrates the Choice Neighborhoods Perkins Somerset Oldtown Transformation Plan





#### **Feedback**


- Preference for Scheme 4 at Public Meeting #2, followed by Scheme 3








## Summary/Highlights of Feedback/Input


- · Football field oriented north-south down the center of the site

- . Drop off loop near building entry plaza







#### City Springs Park Master Plan Concept Summary

#### Option 1:

- · New pool in upper northwest corner of the site
- · Option to move playground to lawn space near City Springs school

#### Option 2:

- · New pool in middle portion of northern half of the site
- · Leaves corners of the park as gateways
- · Option to move playground to lawn space near City Springs school

#### Option 3:

- · Renovate existing pool and pool building
- · Option to move community garden toward the pool to open up the corner gateway


